

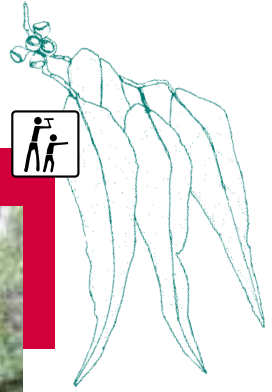

# Meetus Falls Forest Reserve

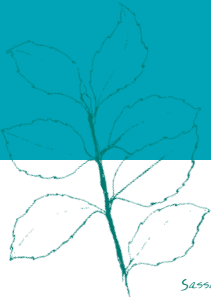
It is a 10 kilometre drive from here to Meetus Falls Forest Reserve. Follow the 'MS' Road north until you see the signposted turnoff to Meetus.

Meetus is a ideal place for a family picnic or barbecue. You can relax amongst the eucalypts with a picnic hamper or have a barbecue in the shelter. A short walk to the lookout platform provides fantastic views of the impressive waterfall which plummets off the rocky escarpment into the valley below. Make Meetus your stop for lunch and you won't be disappointed!

The environment at Meetus is more humid than the other forest reserves. Consequently the forests are wetter and are dominated by 'typical' wet forest eucalypts like stringybark (*Eucalyptus obliqua*) and gum-topped stringybark (*Eucalyptus delegatensis*). Sassafras (*Atherosperma moschatum*), manfernans (*Dicksonia antarctica*) and a rich carpet of moss and ground ferns are even found growing in the moist gullies, protected from fire.
