MAYDENA HUB MANAGERS

Are you good at working with people, can find the best ways to achieve goals, have an eye for providing good tourism experiences but ensuring a sustainable financial return? These jobs might be for you.

The positions are about providing a great forest experience for visitors. The business is based in the town of Maydena and provides a tour to the summit of the Maydena Range. Views from the summit provide a "Rooftop of Tasmania" experience. The journey is the first part in the development of exciting visitor activities in the region. The Hub is expected to be opened by summer 2008/09.

The key job requirements prior to start up are:

- Advise on the development of food and retailing facilities at both the hub building in Maydena and at the Eagles' Eyrie, atop the Maydena Range
- Assist in the identification of potential hub partners and foster business partnerships with suitable operators
- Establish strong working relationships with local and regional tourism bodies in southern Tasmania
- Participate in the commissioning of business systems for FT and tourism partners
- Train staff in interpretation to enhance the visitor experience
- Assist with the marketing of the product.

Interested couples wanting to combine their own business activity with Hub management responsibilities will definitely be considered.

The key job requirements at and after start up:

- Assist with the launch of the project
- Manage staff
- Sell tickets for the ride to the Eagles Eyrie
- Manage and sell food/drinks and a range of merchandise
- Ensure accurate records and accountability maintained at all times
- Co-ordinate and sell tours to other adventure options out of the Maydena hub
- Liaise with other tour operators to attract viable adventure businesses into the hub
- Identify other opportunities that are financially beneficial to the hub
- Maintain a strong community presence and provide a positive business role model for other operators in the valley
- Liaise with other land managers, tourism bodies and communities in order to promote adventure tourism in the region
- Achieve TICT tourism accreditation within 12 months of operation
